



Connecting the Awning to Brackets

- ① Slide the M6*25 T-bolts (12X) into the groove openings of the roof platform's sliding track.
- ② Adjust the T-bolts along the track, positioning 4 bolts per track.
- ③ Pre-fix the brackets using M6 flange nuts, ensuring they remain movable within the track.
- Adjust the spacing between the two brackets (insufficient spacing may compromise stability).






Mounting Brackets to the STORM Roof Rack

- ① Insert M10 spring nuts (4X) into the groove openings of the track.
- 2 Position 2 spring nuts per track for optimal stability.
- ③ Pre-fix the brackets using M10*25 bolts (4X), allowing adjustment along the track.
- 4 Align the awning proportionally to the vehicle, then fully tighten all M6 flange nuts (12X).

Tip: For tight spaces, secure individual nuts first, remove the awning, then tighten all bolts.

⑤ Finalize installation by tightening the M10*25 bolts (4X) at the M8 spring nut positions.



Usage Precautions

- 1. Before use, carefully watch the installation video tutorial.
- Strictly follow the manufacturer's installation guidelines to ensure correct and secure installation, guaranteeing the stability of the side awning.
- 3. Before use, ensure the vehicle is parked on a level surface for safety.
- 4. When in use, stay as far away as possible from open flames or smoke to prevent fire hazards.
- When in use, monitor wind and weather conditions. In strong winds, secure the awning with ground pegs and guy ropes to prevent damage.
- After use, remove debris from inside and outside the awning. Ensure it is completely dry before storage to prevent mold and corrosion.
- 7. When storing the awning, keep it in a dry, ventilated area to prevent mold or deformation.
- 8. After installing the side awning on the vehicle, repeatedly check that the mounting brackets are securely tightened.
- The awning contains high-pressure springs.
 Disassembly by non-professionals is strictly prohibited.
- Regularly inspect all awning components and ensure the screws between the brackets and the vehicle are properly tightened.
- 11. Avoid hanging excessive weight on the side awning to prevent bracket deformation or damage due to overloading.

Care instructions

1.Cleaning:

- Use a soft towel and cold water to remove dirt.
- Avoid soap, detergents, petrol, or other solvents.

2.Drying & Storage:

- Dry the awning promptly if it becomes wet.
- Ensure it is completely dry before storage to prevent mold.
- Store in a dry, ventilated area to avoid deformation or mildew.

3. Usage Restrictions:

- Avoid using the awning in extreme weather conditions (e.g., storms, heavy snow).
- Do not drive the vehicle while the side awning is deployed.

4. Safety Warnings:

- The side awning is designed as a temporary shelter for camping, not a permanent structure.
- Do not use it for extended periods or leave it unattended after deployment to prevent injury or damage.

5. Regular Inspection:

• Periodically inspect the awning to ensure it remains dry. Clean promptly if moisture or debris is present.

6.Warranty Note:

- Proper storage is crucial for the awning's longevity.
- Damage caused by damp or moldy storage conditions is not covered under warranty.
